ADVERTISEMENT FOR RECRUITMENT TO VARIOUS GROUP-A NON-FACULTY POSTS ON DIRECT RECRUITMENT BASIS AT AIIMS NAGPUR

AIIMS Nagpur is an apex healthcare Institute, established by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojna (PMSSY) with the aim of correcting regional imbalances in quality tertiary level healthcare in the country and attaining self-sufficiency in graduate and postgraduate medical education and training.

The Executive Director, AIIMS Nagpur invites online applications from eligible Indian nationals for recruitment to the following Group - A Non-Faculty posts on direct recruitment basis:

- Eligibility criteria, selection procedure etc. for the above-mentioned posts are given in the succeeding paragraphs.
- Reservation and/or relaxation to candidates belonging to various categories i.e. SC, ST, OBC-NCL, EWS, PwBD, Ex-SM will be as per the GoI rules on production of relevant and valid certificate in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India.
- In the posts identified suitable for PwBD candidates (with specified disability) horizontal reservation of 4% and other relaxations as per the Govt. of India rules shall be admissible. Eligible PwBD candidates are encouraged to apply.
- The above vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. The Executive Director, AIIMS Nagpur reserves the right to vary the vacancies including reserved vacancies as per the Govt. of India Rules/Circulars and requirements. The Institute may cancel the advertisement or cancel selection as felt necessary. Therefore, a candidates are

advised to regularly visit our website for any updates about this advertisement & selection process.

I. Important instructions to candidates:

1. The cut-off date for determining the eligibility of candidates with regard to age, educational qualification and experience of the candidates shall be **the last date of submission of online application**. The online application link for the above-mentioned posts, along with other relevant information **will be from 08.08.2026, 12:00 A.M.** The last date for submission of online applications is **07.09.2026, 11:59 P.M.**
 2. The period of experience wherever prescribed shall be counted after obtaining the prescribed essential qualifications.
 3. The candidates are advised to submit the Online Application well in advance without waiting for the closing date.
 4. The aspiring candidates fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria for the post are required to apply only **online** as per procedure given in this advertisement.
 5. AIIMS Nagpur will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for eligibility and other aspects before or at the time of CBT and therefore, candidature/application will be accepted only **provisionally**. Before applying, candidates must go through the eligibility criteria viz. Educational qualification, experience, age etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post. Candidature may be cancelled forthwith without any further notice if any information or claim is not found substantiated during recruitment process/document verification.
 6. **CANDIDATES TO ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE RECRUITMENT:** The candidates applying for the post/vacancy should ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions for the post applied to. Their candidature at all the stages of the recruitment will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.
 7. **MINIMUM ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:** All applicants must fulfil the essential requirements of the post and other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. They are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess at least the essential qualifications laid down for various posts. No enquiry asking for advice as to eligibility will be entertained.
- NOTE:** In respect of equivalent clause in Essential Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of advertisement, the candidate is required to produce order/letter in this regard, indicating the Authority (with number and date) under which it has been so treated otherwise the online recruitment application is liable to be rejected. However, final decision regarding equivalence of qualification and selection of such candidates will be taken by the AIIMS Nagpur.
8. The period of experience rendered by a candidate on part time basis, daily wages, visiting/guest faculty will not be counted while calculating the valid experience for short listing the candidates for interview.
 9. If any document/certificate furnished is in a language other than Hindi or English, a transcript of the same duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or notary is to be submitted.
 10. In the event of receiving a large number of applications, AIIMS Nagpur reserves the right to adopt appropriate shortlisting criteria to restrict the number of candidates called for interview to a reasonable number, including conducting a Computer Based Test (CBT), if necessary.

11. THE CANDIDATE SHOULD MENTION ALL HIS/HER QUALIFICATIONS AND RELEVANT EXPERIENCE IN THE RELEVANT FIELD, OVER AND ABOVE THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED QUALIFICATIONS.
12. Candidates are **not required** to submit to the AIIMS Nagpur the printouts of their online applications or any other document either by post or by hand. They will be required to bring with them the printouts of their online applications and the relevant documents, if called for interview.
13. Candidates working in Central/State/UT Government Organizations/ PSUs/Autonomous Bodies must obtain prior permission from their employer before applying for the post and should possess a No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued on or before the last date of submission of the online application. The NOC shall be produced at the time of Document Verification (DV) or as and when called for by the Institute. Failure to produce the NOC shall render the candidate ineligible for further recruitment process.
14. As per Ministry of Human Resource Development Notification dated 10-06-2015 published in the Gazette of India all the degrees/ diplomas/ certificates awarded through Open and Distance Learning mode of education by the Universities established by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature, Institutions Deemed to be Universities under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and Institutions of National Importance declared under an Act of Parliament stand automatically recognized for the purpose of employment to posts and services under the Central Government provided they have been approved by the Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission. Accordingly, unless such degrees are recognized for the relevant period when the candidates acquired the qualification, they will not be accepted for the purpose of Educational Qualification. In case of the candidates possessing such degrees/ diplomas/ certificates awarded through Open and Distance Learning mode of education, such candidates shall also produce approval given to the University by the Distance Education Bureau, University Grants Commission for the relevant period at the time of Document Verification.
15. As per UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 published in official Gazette on 23-06-2017, under Part-III (8) (v), the programmes in engineering, medicine, dental, nursing, pharmacy, architecture and physiotherapy etc. are not permitted to be offered under Open and Distance Learning mode. However, pursuant to the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 11-03-2019 in MA No. 3092/2018 in W.P. (C) No. 382/2018 titled Mukul Kumar Sharma & others Vs AICTE and others, B. Tech. degree/ diploma in Engineering awarded by IGNOU to the students who were enrolled up to academic year 2009-10 shall be treated as valid, wherever applicable.
16. Reserve category candidates who are selected on their own merit without any relaxed standards will be accommodated against the unreserved vacancies as per their position in the order of merit. The reserved vacancies will be filled up from amongst the eligible relevant reserved category candidates in the order of merit.
17. Reserved category candidates who qualify on the basis of relaxed standards viz. age limit, experience, qualifications, etc, irrespective of their merit position will be counted against reserved vacancies only.
18. A person with benchmark disability (PwBD) who is selected on his own merit can be appointed against an unreserved vacancy provided the post is identified suitable for persons with benchmark disability (PwBD) of relevant category.
19. Benefits to PwBD will be allowed in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and Rules framed there-under. Benefit under the PwBD category will be admissible to only those who suffer from not less than 40% of specified disability. Such PwBD candidates have to submit a Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format.

20. Specified/suitable category of disabilities for the posts for PwBD candidates will be as per the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India, Notification No. 38-16/2020-DD-III dated 04.01.2021 and as decided by the appointing authority considering the functional/physical requirements of the post. AIIMS Nagpur may verify the authenticity of the certificate of disability and examine suitability of the candidate in terms of functional requirements before appointment. In this regard, the decision of the AIIMS Nagpur will be final.
21. **Medical Fitness:** Appointment of selected candidates is subject to his/her being declared medically fit by the competent Medical Board.
22. **Probation:** Persons selected will be appointed on probation as per the extant rule.
23. **Final Decision:** The decision of AIIMS Nagpur in all matters relating to this recruitment will be final and binding on the candidates and no representation/correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

II. Eligibility Criteria: As given in **Annexure-I.**

III. Pattern/Scheme/Syllabus of Examination: As given in **Annexure-II.**

IV. Age Relaxation:

- Upper age limit shall be determined as on last date of submission of online applications.
- Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate only will be accepted by the AIIMS Nagpur for determining the age and no subsequent request for change will not be considered or granted.
- Age relaxation and/or reservation shall be admissible to SC/ST/OBC candidates only against the **vacancies reserved for them** on submission of valid caste/category certificate. The caste/community of such candidate should be included in the list of reserved communities issued by the Central Government.
- No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying for unreserved vacancies.
- OBC candidate's eligibility will be based on Castes borne in the Central List of Govt. of India. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy layer. Their sub-caste should match with the entries in Central List of OBC, failing which their candidature will not be considered under any of the applied reserved category and will be treated as UR.
- Physical Disability Certificate should be issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board.
- Permissible relaxation of upper age limit as per Government orders as on the last date of receipt of online applications are as under:

Candidates claiming age relaxation under this para would be

		required to produce a certificate in the prescribed proforma to the Commission. NOTE: Ex-Servicemen who have already secured regular employment under the Central Govt. in a Civil Post are permitted the benefit of age relaxation as admissible for Ex-Servicemen for securing another employment in any higher post or service under the Central Govt. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation, if any for Ex-Servicemen in Central Govt. jobs. (b) In order to qualify for the concession under (a) above, candidates concerned would be required to produce a certificate that they have been released from the Defence Forces. The Certificate for Ex-Servicemen and Commissioned Officers including ECOs/SSCOs should be signed by the appropriate authorities specified below and should also specify the period of service in the Defence Forces:- (i) In case of Commissioned Officers including ECOs/SSCOs: Army: Directorate of Personnel Services, Army Headquarters, New Delhi. Navy: Directorate of Personnel Services, Naval Headquarters, New Delhi. Air Force: Directorate of Personnel Services, Air Headquarters, New Delhi. (ii) In case of JCOs/ORs and equivalent of the Navy and Air Force: Army : By various Regimental Record Offices. Navy : Naval Records, Mumbai. Air Force: Air Force Records, New Delhi.

NOTE-I: Ex-Servicemen who have already secured employment in civil side under Central Government on regular basis after availing of the benefits of reservation given to ex-servicemen for their re-employment are NOT eligible for fee concession. However, they are eligible for age relaxation as per Rules.

NOTE-II: Ex-servicemen/Commissioned Officers seeking age relaxation shall be required to produce Discharge Book/ documents issued by the competent authority in support of their category to avail admissible benefits (reservation /relaxation).

NOTE-III: The period of “Call up Service” of an Ex-Servicemen in the Armed Forces shall also be treated as service rendered in the Armed forces for purpose of age relaxation as per Rules.

EXPLANATION: An “Ex-serviceman” means a person: -

(i) Who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Union of India, and

(a) Who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after his or her pension; or

(b) Who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstance beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or

(c) Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment; or

(ii) Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service;

OR

(iii) Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal Service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or

(iv) Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1988; or

(v) Gallantry Award winners of the Armed Forces including Personnel of Territorial Army; or

(vi) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

NOTE-III: AGE CONCESSION IS NOT ADMISSIBLE TO SONS, DAUGHTERS AND DEPENDENTS OF EX-SERVICEMEN.

V. Application Fee: A non-refundable application fee is required to be paid only in online/digital mode. Applications without the prescribed fee (unless exempted) shall be summarily rejected. Fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor can the fee be held in reserve for any other examination. The application fee applicable to various categories is as follow:-

VI. Certificates:

1. Date(s) of valid OBC (NCL) certificate: Candidates applying under OBC category must produce the valid caste certificate in the format provided by the DoP&T vide O.M No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res.) dated 30.05.2014 and further clarification issued by DoP&T OM No. 36011/1/12-Estt.(Res.) dated 14.03.2016. The certificate must mention the non-creamy layer status of the applicant (Non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 8.9.1993). The OBC applicants who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs (notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes available at the website <http://ncbc.nic.in>, shall be eligible to be considered under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC Certificate in respect of non-creamy layer status of the applicants as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res-I) dated 31st March 2016). The validity of the non-creamy layer certificate should be issued for the financial year 2026-2027 (considering income upto financial year ending on 31st March 2026) issued on or after 01st April 2026 and on or before 31st March 2027.

2. Date(s) of valid EWS certificate: - The vacancies advertised under EWS Category are as per the instructions issued by DoPT, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension, Govt. of India, vide OM. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019. Application under EWS category will be considered subject to submission of Income and Assets certificate on a prescribed format issued by the competent authority and subject to verification of genuineness of the certificate by the issuing authority. In pursuance to DoP&T OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019, a EWS certificate issued in prescribed format for employment in Central Government on the basis of income of financial year 2025-2026 issued from 01.04.2026 valid for the financial year 2026-2027 will be considered valid.

VII. Date & Centre of Examination:

1. **Date of Online (CBT) mode Examination/Interview will be intimated later on only AIIMS Nagpur, Website.**

2. **Test Centre:** CBT, if any, to be held at the below mentioned cities. Candidates must indicate their preference in the order of priority in the online application form in which they desire to take the CBT. However, the Institute reserves the right to cancel any of the Centre on ground of less number of candidates or any other ground and ask candidates of that centre to appear from another centre/city. Further, no request for change of examination/CBT centre once allotted will be entertained, Candidates will have to appear at the allotted centre at his/her own arrangement and expenses. Tentative test will ordinarily be conducted at the following centres: **Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai/Thane/Navi Mumbai/MMR, Nagpur and New Delhi/Delhi NCR.**

NOTE: The list of test centres is subject to change. Any such changes will be notified to candidates through the AIIMS Nagpur website prior to the conduct of the CBT.

3. **e-Admit Card for CBT:** Candidates shall be issued an e-Admit Card for appearing in CBT. The e-Admit Card will be made available on the website of AIIMS Nagpur for downloading by candidates. 'Admit Card' will **not** be sent to candidates by any other mode. In case of any discrepancies/errors in e-Admit Card, candidates must immediately report the same to the Recruitment Cell, AIIMS Nagpur for correction.

4. Candidates must note that merely issuing of e-Admit Card to them will not imply that their candidature has been finally cleared by the Institute. The Institute will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents only after the candidate qualifies the CBT or for Interview, as the case may be.

5. Candidates will be shortlisted for interview on the basis of the information provided by them in their online application and their performance in the Computer Based Test (CBT), if held. They must ensure that such information is true. If at any subsequent stage or at the time of interview any information given by them or any claim made by them in their online, applications is found to be false, their candidature will be liable to be rejected.

6. Result of CBT: Result of CBT will be published on the website of AIIMS Nagpur in due course. No separate correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

VIII. Selection Procedure:

The mode of selection will be based on the performance of Interview only, however the Institute may hold a Screening Test/CBT or any other screening process to shortlist candidates to be called for Interview in those posts against which more eligible candidates will apply. The decision of the Institute in this regard will be final. The performance in Screening Test/CBT will carry no weightage in the Interview and the final selection will be based on the performance of the Interview only.

IMPORTANT
(i) The category-wise minimum level of suitability in interviews, irrespective of whether the selection is made only by interview or by CBT followed by interview, will be UR/EWS-50 Marks, OBC-45 Marks, SC/ST/PwBD-40 marks, out of the total marks of interview being 100.
(ii) In cases where selection is made by Computer Based Test (CBT) followed by Interview, the candidate will have to achieve minimum level of suitability in their respective category at both stages i.e., 'CBT' as well as 'Interview'. The minimum level of suitability in case of CBT shall be decided by the Competent Authority of AIIMS Nagpur on case to case basis.
(iii) A candidate, who qualifies a CBT, if any, must satisfy all other eligibility criteria for the vacancy as advertised.

Document Verification: Original documents of shortlisted candidates in the order of merit (to a certain extent with reference to the number of vacancies) will be verified in due course. The date and details of document verification will be notified on the website of AIIMS Nagpur after declaration of CBT result.

Final Result: The final result (i.e. list of selected candidates) will be published on the website of AIIMS Nagpur.

IX. General Instructions to Candidates:

1. All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur is an autonomous body under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India. Service under the Institute is governed by the Act and the Rules / Regulations framed under the Act.
2. The post(s) is/are whole time and will not engage in any trade or business or undertake any employment full-time or part-time while in the service of the Institute without the explicit permission of the Executive Director, AIIMS Nagpur or the Officer authorized by him/her in this behalf.
3. On appointment, in addition to pay, selected candidates will be entitled to other allowances and service benefits i.e. DA, HRA (or accommodation), TA, Leave, LTC, NPS, Employee Health Scheme etc. as admissible to employees of AIIMS Nagpur.
4. All the appointees are expected to conform to the rules of conduct and discipline as applicable to the employees of AIIMS Nagpur.
5. Without prejudice to criminal/legal/disciplinary action, the candidate is liable to be disqualified from the CBT/recruitment process on account of the following:-
 - (a) Using unfair means during the CBT/recruitment process; or
 - (b) Violating any of the instructions given in the e-Admit Card; or
 - (c) Impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person; or
 - (d) Misbehaving in the examination hall / place of document verification (DV); or

- (e) Damaging infrastructure/equipment in the examination hall/place of DV; or
 - (f) Obstructing the conduct of examination/recruitment process; or
 - (g) Instigating other candidates to boycott the examination / DV process; or
 - (h) Making statements which are incorrect or false, suppressing material information, submitting fabricated documents, etc. or
 - (i) Any other inappropriate and undisciplined behaviour during the process.
6. The candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
7. Canvassing in any form will result in disqualification of candidature.
8. In case, any information or declaration given by the candidate is found to be false or if the candidate has wilfully suppressed any material information relevant to this recruitment, he/she will be liable to be removed from the service and/or action, as deemed fit, may be taken against him/her by the appointing authority.
9. Date of birth filled by the candidate in the online application form and the same recorded in the Matriculation/ Secondary Examination Certificate will be accepted by the Institute for determining the age and no subsequent request for change will be considered or granted.
10. Candidates should note that their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the document submitted by them is verified by AIIMS Nagpur.
11. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the Institute reserves the right to modify/withdraw any communication made to the candidate.
12. The Executive Director, AIIMS Nagpur reserves the right of any amendment, cancellation, and changes to this advertisement as a whole or in part without assigning any reason.
13. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the recruitment process/test/interview.
14. Communication with candidates regarding recruitment process will be made through email ID provided by them in their online application form.

16. All the records related to this recruitment will be preserved up to 6 months from the date of declaration of result and thereafter, these shall stand destroyed except for selected candidates and matter pending in Hon'ble CAT/Court.
17.
