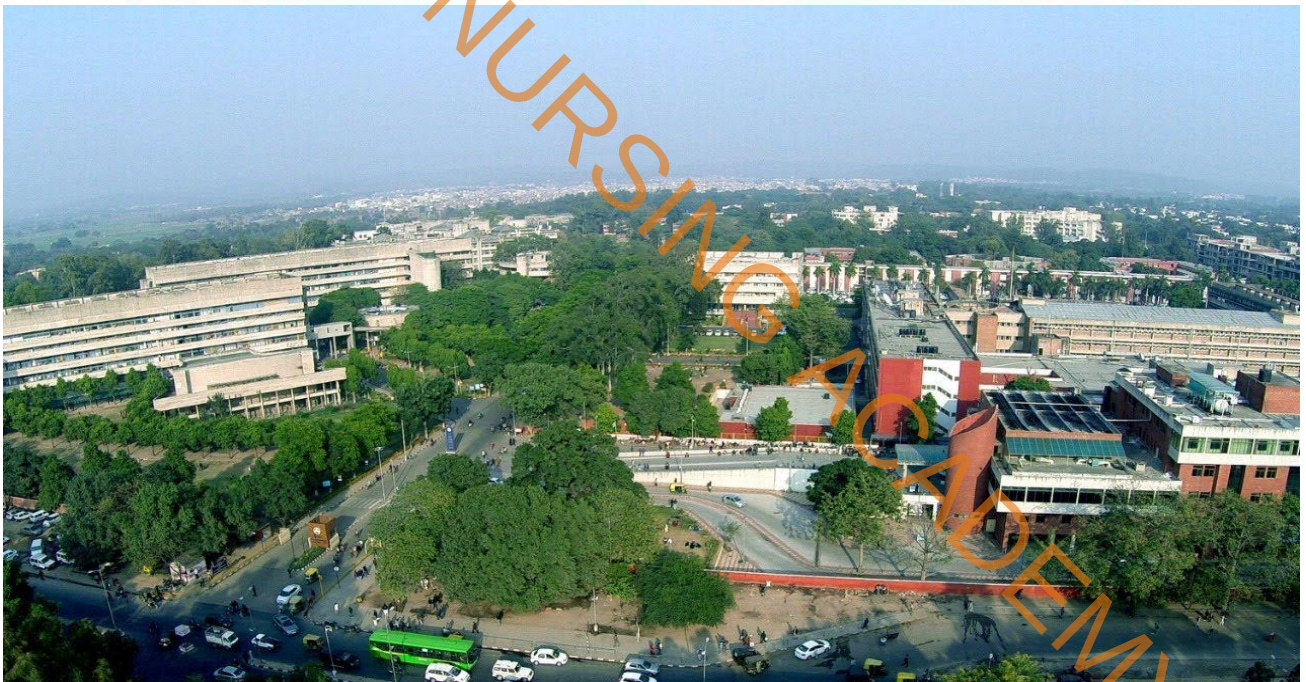

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1. INTRODUCTION

The Government of India, Ministry of Health had set up a committee known as the “HEALTH SURVEY AND PLANNING COMMITTEE” on 12th June, 1959 to undertake the review of the development that had taken place since the publication of the report of HEALTH SURVEY AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (BHORE COMMITTEE) in 1946 with a view to formulate further health programme for the country in the third and subsequent five year plan periods. This committee recommended the setting up of six Postgraduate Medical Institutions in the country, one each at Kolkata, Mumbai, Chennai, Hyderabad, Lucknow and Chandigarh to meet the increasing demand of teachers for the rapidly expanding Medical Colleges specialist services for hospitals, and need of the armed forces.

The Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education & Research was conceived and planned in 1960 to create in Chandigarh “ISLAND OF EXCELLENCE” providing physical and intellectual milieu for young scientists working in multiple disciplines of medicine, to advance the frontiers of knowledge, render humane service to sick and suffering and to train medical, nursing and paramedical manpower. The Institute was established in 1962 under the erstwhile state of Punjab. It was declared as an Institute of National importance by an Act of Parliament (Act 51 of 1966) w.e.f. 1st April, 1967.

The College of Nursing was established in 1964 in Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh with an aim to bring primary health services within the reach of all individuals. From 2003 onwards College of Nursing, PGI, Chandigarh stands upgraded and renamed as National Institute of Nursing Education (NINE), Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh. Earlier the Nursing Institute was offering graduate and postgraduate degree courses in nursing under Panjab University. According to Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh Amendment Act-2008 (No. 3 of 2008), degrees are now awarded by this Institute. NINE is also designated as WHO Collaborative centre since 2003.

The Nursing Institute has been preparing clinical practitioners, nursing administrators and educators to shoulder responsible positions and facilitate better education with added thrust to nursing research and short term courses in specialties of nursing. Faculty and students/alumni are members of National/International Professional Organizations.

2. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The following are the aims and objectives of the Institute:

1. To prepare nurse clinicians for bedside and family care nursing, nursing supervision and nursing administration.
2. To prepare nursing teachers for Nursing Colleges and University level Nursing Institutes.
3. To prepare nursing personnel to conduct research related to delivery of nursing care services.
4. To prepare nursing personnel to develop nursing literature.

* Reservation to PwBD candidates is given on horizontal basis and as per Govt. of India guidelines revised from time to time. As per latest guidelines from Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, GOI, published through Gazette notification dated 16.10.2024, Any person with specified disability may apply online in form -IV for obtaining a disability certificate / UDID card.

- The number of seats mentioned for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) will be adjusted against the category to which he / she belongs.
- The candidates having disability of locomotor to the tune of **40% to 50%** of lower extremity declared by authorized Medical Board of the State Govt. / Govt. of India or any other Competent Authority authorized in this regard by the Government having Nursing expert as a member of the Board only to be considered. All the prospective candidates under this category are advised to obtain fresh PwBD / Disability certificate from the concerned competent authority having nursing expert as a member in accordance with norms of Indian Nursing council for admission in nursing courses, failing which, their candidature will be rejected without assigning any reasons.
- Any candidate, who is having UDID card for claiming reservation meant for PwBD, must submit the disability certificate as per the **form V** (for single disability) or **form VI** (for multiple disabilities) as prescribed on the website "depwd.gov.in" (also given specimen at **Annex- VII & Annex- VIII** in the prospectus).
- Candidates having Color blindness are eligible provided that their color blindness can be corrected with contact lens and spectacles worn by such candidates.

Note:

1. The specialty shall be offered to the candidates as per the merit list of entrance test.
2. The specialty will be changed only at the time of counseling on the basis of merit in the entrance test.
3. Specialties for the M.Sc. Nursing in Medical Surgical Nursing in any one of the above sub specialty shall be opted by the candidate by **31st August, 2026**.
4. In the last / mop up round of counseling / spot counseling, the unfilled seats of reserved categories (if any) will be de-reserved and offered in order of merit to available eligible candidates irrespective of category (only upon the non-availability of eligible candidates of reserved categories), without any reduction of eligibility criteria / qualifying marks.

5. ADMISSION TO M.Sc. NURSING COURSE

The duration of M.Sc. Nursing course is of two academic years. Admission to M.Sc. Nursing course is made once a year. The session commences from 16th July every year. The admission notice is published in leading newspapers in India usually during the months of March / April every year. The admission to the course imparted at NINE is made on All India Basis by holding (computer based test) CBT an entrance examination by the Institute after issuing a countrywide admission notice.

6. GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A. ELGIBILITY (to be reckoned as on the last date of submission of online application form):

- 1) Candidates must have either a B.Sc. Nursing (4 yrs) / B.Sc. Nursing (Post-Basic) from an Institution recognized by the concerned State Nursing Registration Council with at least 55% marks in aggregate.
- 2) Should have minimum one year of work experience* after registration as Registered Nurse & registered Midwife by **09.05.2026** (the last date for submission of applications) in bed-side nursing in a minimum of 100 bedded capacity hospital (for private hospitals only) or Public Health Nursing or in Nursing Educational Institutions recognized by the State(s) Nursing Council after obtaining B.Sc. Nursing (4 years) or before and after Post-Basic B.Sc. Nursing. **The experience certificate in this regard must be on the letter head of the hospital and should clearly indicate the bed capacity of the hospital in terms of number of beds and should be approved by State / Central Govt.(s) failing which experience will not be considered.** This period of experience so gained by the candidates in all cases must be after having registration done with concerned State Nursing Registration Council and no prior experience from the date of registration would be taken into consideration for any purposes.
- *Those candidates who are LIKELY TO COMPLETE REQUIRED EXPERIENCE BY LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION HAVE TO BRING THE EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATE AT THE TIME OF DOCUMENT VERIFICATION as well as COUNSELING. No request for extension to submit the experience certificate shall be entertained.**
- 3) Should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife as approved by State Nursing Council or substitute registration in the case of male candidates fully qualified for nursing of men, women and children.
- 4) For Reserved Seats no certificate issued after the closing date will be considered for claiming reservation for SC/ST/OBC/ and PwBD.

NOTE: Applicants must fulfill all the above eligibility conditions on or before the last day of submission of online application form.

B. OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS & REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

1. FOREIGN NATIONAL CANDIDATES

- (i) Foreign nationals should fill in the prescribed application form online.
- (ii) Candidates are required to take the printout of the filled online application form and route their applications along with necessary documents through the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi.
- (iii) The online application form will be treated as an advance copy.
- (iv) However, application of such candidates will be processed after receiving the same through diplomatic channels. These candidates are also required to appear in the entrance examination along with other candidates. The applications should reach the Institute **atleast one week before Entrance examination** i.e. by **23.05.2026**.

2. IN-SERVICE CANDIDATES of NURSING DIVISION or NINE it-self

- (i) In-service candidates of PGIMER, Chandigarh are advised to FIRST SEEK NOC FROM THE concerned Establishment (MS office or Main Establishment) AND THEN FILL THEIR ONLINE APPLICATIONS, in their own interest for appearing in Entrance test for the said course. Candidates are required to take the printout of the filled online application form and submit the same to the office of Principal, NINE, PGIMER, Chandigarh, atleast one week before the entrance test i.e. by **23.05.2026** ALONG-WITH NOC / NECESSARY DOCUMENTS THROUGH THEIR EMPLOYER. Candidates are also required to retain a copy of the same with them as well.

- (ii) The online application form will be treated as an advance copy.

Those candidates who are **LIKELY TO COMPLETE REQUIRED EXPERIENCE BY LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION HAVE TO BRING THE EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATE AT THE TIME OF DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND COUNSELING. No request for extension to submit the experience certificate shall be entertained.**

3. IN-SERVICE CANDIDATES (other than PGIMER Chandigarh/ out-side candidate)

- (i) All in-service candidates (other than of PGIMER), if willing to apply as sponsored / study leave/ other service based applications to pursue the M.Sc. (N) at NINE, are instructed to initiate this action for taking NOC from their cadre controlling authority / employer in advance without waiting for last date of applying, examination date or of counselling date.
- (ii) They must submit their *NOC issued by uploading in their online format while applying, failing which, their application would be rejected out-right & no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

*** Any other alternative document uploaded in lieu of NOC issued by the competent authority would result in cancellation of application & no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.**

Those candidates who are **LIKELY TO COMPLETE REQUIRED EXPERIENCE BY LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION HAVE TO BRING THE EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATE AT THE TIME OF DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND COUNSELING. No request for extension to submit the experience certificate shall be entertained.**

7. RESERVATION OF SEATS

A. Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) & Other Backward Classes (OBC)

- 1) PGIMER, Chandigarh provides Reservation for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC) - Non Creamy Layer (NCL), wherever applicable and admissible as per instructions from Government of India.
- 2) All candidates, irrespective of category may be considered against UR seats, subject to fulfilment of parameters for UR candidates. However, against the seats earmarked for specific categories (SC / ST / OBC), only candidates belonging to that community will be considered.
- 3) For SC / ST / OBC candidates should furnish Certificate as per the format given at Annexure-II (for SC/ST candidates) and at Annexure-III (for OBC-NCL candidates from competent authorities for claiming Reservations at the time of admission.
 - a) Further, in case of OBC candidates, the certificate should specifically indicate that they do not belong to the Persons / Sections (Creamy Layer) mentioned in Column 3 of the Schedule of the Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training O.M.No.36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08.09.93 & its subsequent revision through O.M.No.36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 09.03.2004, No. 36033/3/2004-Est(Res) dated 14.10.2008, OM no. 36033/1/2013-Estt.(Res) dated 27.05.2013, 36033/1/2013-Estt.(Res) 13.09.2017 and further revision, if any, received till the closing date for ONLINE Registration of applications for entrance test.
 - b) The candidates should ensure that they belong to the OBC category while applying for the seats.
 - c) Such candidates should produce a valid OBC certificate issued in the prescribed format of central govt. (as given in the prospectus) during document verification and counselling, which shall not be older than one year from the closing date of application.
 - d) Further, in addition to the category certificate (OBC), a declaration in the prescribed format as per Annexure-IV has to be furnished by the candidates during document verification, that he / she does not belong to the creamy layer.
 - e) In case of not complying with these stipulations, their claim for reserved status (OBC) will not be entertained.

B. PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITY (PwBD)

- 1) As per provisions (Chapter VI Clause 32) of the Rights of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 5% (five percent) of seats shall be reserved for Persons (Indian Nationals only) with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD). The reservation will be provided on horizontal basis, as per their rank in order of merit in Entrance Test.
- 2) The number of seats mentioned for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) will be adjusted against the category to which he / she belongs. The candidates having disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of lower extremity declared by authorized Medical Board of the State Govt. / Govt. of India or any other Competent Authority authorized in this regard by the Government having Nursing expert as a member of the Board only to be considered. All the perspective candidates under this category are advised to obtain fresh PwBD / Disability certificate from the concerned competent authority having nursing expert as a member in accordance with norms of Indian Nursing council for admission in nursing courses, failing which, their candidature will be rejected without assigning any reason.
- 3) Candidates having Color blindness are eligible provided that their color blindness can be corrected with contact lens and spectacles worn by such candidates.

8. SELECTION PROCEDURE

8.1 COMPETITIVE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (Computer Based Test):

The Entrance Examination shall be conducted through a Computer Based Test (CBT).

The Entrance Test shall be held on **31st May 2026** and duration shall be 1½ hours (One and a half hours / 90 minutes).

The Online (CBT) Entrance Test will be conducted in one shift:

Timing : 09:00 AM to 10:30 AM.

IMPORTANT :- TO AVOID ANY HASSLE TO REACH THE EXAMINATION CENTRE ON TIME, THE CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO VISIT THEIR RESPECTIVE EXAMINATION CENTRE ONE DAY PRIOR TO THE EXAMINATION OR AS PER THEIR CONVENIENCE.

8.2 EXAMINATION CITIES/CENTRES:

- (i) Applicants should indicate his/her choice of city of examination at the time of filling online application form. The city of examination shall be allotted on first-come first-serve basis subject to availability of nodes in respective city.
- (ii) The city of examination once chosen and allotted will not be changed and no request in this regard will be entertained. Applicants should, therefore, fill the choice of examination city for entrance test with utmost care as per their suitability to reach the destination easily to attend the exam.

- (iii) Applicants are advised to complete the process of online application at the earliest without waiting for the last date, to avoid not getting the city /centre of their choice.

Note: While PGI shall make all possible efforts to allocate the cities chosen by candidates, however due to technical, logistic and other unforeseen reasons including non-availability of sufficient number of Examination Centres or Candidates in that city or natural calamities etc., some centres may be cancelled. Under such circumstances, PGI shall re-allocate these candidates to alternate centres in nearby cities. Such decisions for allocation of centre / city shall be binding on the candidate.

(iv) Other Important Instructions:

- No electronic / metal items and ornaments inside the exam centre will be allowed.
- Shoes / footwear with thick soles and garments with large buttons will not be permitted.
- For details please see and follow instructions given in the admit card.

(v) Unfair means, cheating, forgery and impersonation:

The candidates will not resort to adopt any unfair means, cheating, forgery and impersonation during the examination. In case a candidate is caught guilty of such act he / she shall be expelled from the examination hall and examination of such candidates including the outcome shall be terminated / cancelled right away. Such candidate's in-possession prohibited items shall be confiscated immediately by the invigilator. Identity and communication details of candidate shall be noted down by invigilators / observer for reporting to authorities in TCS / PGI / Police Authorities. Forgery is a cognizable offence and attracts strict disciplinary action. An FIR may also be lodged with the police for such defaulting candidates.

Any request for reappearing and refund of fees shall not be accepted.

- (vi) The latest covid protocol needs to be followed by appearing candidates as per instructions of respective state govt. / Govt. of India/ PGIMER wherever it will apply.

8.3 TYPE OF PAPER

Candidates will be considered for selection to M.Sc. Nursing course based on a test consisting of 100 multiple choice questions (MCQs) with four options. There will be **Negative marking** to the tune of **0.25 marks for each wrong answer**.

9. MERIT LIST

Merit list of candidates is prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the online entrance examination. Merit list is prepared for each category of candidates viz.

- (a) General
- (b) Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes / Other Backward Communities
- (c) Persons with Benchmark Disability
- (d) PGI In services candidates

N.B. Seats for these categories are not interchangeable. However, PwBD candidates selected under PwBD category will consume the seat of their own category like GEN/ SC/ ST/ OBC.

10. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

1. The selection will be made strictly in order of merit of the candidates in the respective merit lists of entrance test.
2. An overall merit list based on the percentile obtained by all the candidates appearing in the entrance examination (irrespective of their category) will be prepared. Candidates of various categories who secure percentile in the theory examination, as mentioned against each category, will qualify for admission:
General category : 50th percentile
SC / ST / OBC & PwBD : 45th percentile
3. In the matter of selection, the decision of the Director, PGIMER, Chandigarh shall be final.

11. INTER-SE-MERIT (FOR TIE BREAK CASES)

If two or more candidates obtain equal percentile in the entrance examination for admission to M.Sc. Nursing course then their inter-se-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following:-

1. A candidate who has made more attempts in passing qualifying exam, (B.Sc. Nursing) will rank junior to a candidate who has made lesser attempts.
2. If the attempts made in passing qualifying exam (B.Sc. Nursing) are also the same, then a candidate who has higher marks in the said examination (B.Sc. Nursing) will rank senior to a candidate who has obtained lower marks.
3. If the attempts made in passing the said examinations and the marks obtained in the examinations are also the same, then a candidate senior in age shall rank senior to the candidate who is junior in age.

12. DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND COUNSELING

Candidates will be invited for physical DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND COUNSELING at PGIMER, Chandigarh in order of merit in the respective merit lists based on the marks obtained by them in the entrance examination. Document verification of such candidates will be done by the scrutiny committee, hence, original documents of the candidates will be required on the day of DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AS WELL AS COUNSELING. The number of candidates to be called for the interview will be three times the total number of seats to be filled in each category from candidates who fulfill the cut off points. **It is compulsory that these candidates attend the Document verification and interview / counseling. Any change in date of counseling will be notified on the PGIMER, Chandigarh website. Hence, candidates are advised to keep visiting PGIMER, Chandigarh website frequently for all the updates.**

13. ADMISSION

Selected candidates during counseling should pay the fee etc. on the spot failing which, her / his selection will be treated as cancelled and seat will be offered to the candidate next on the waiting list in order of merit. **Therefore, it is advised to get their Demand draft (DD) / banker Cheque (purchased/issued from Bank and not from the personal cheque book) ready while attending the counseling in favour of "Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh." as per amount notified in the prospectus.**

14. WAITING LIST

The seats, if available, shall be offered to the candidates on merit. The candidates on the waiting list will attend the counseling in the office of the Principal, NINE, PGIMER, Chandigarh on the dates & time to be announced on the day of 1st counseling or as notified on the PGIMER website. No separate correspondence shall be made.

15. JOINING TIME

Selected candidates must join their course on the date intimated to them at the time of selection or communicated to them in the admission letter. No extension in joining shall be granted. The selection of those candidates who fail to join by the stipulated date shall automatically stand cancelled and no correspondence shall be entertained.

THE INSTITUTE TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY OF INTIMATING FOR CANCELLATION OF SEATS.

1. The joining of in-service candidates for M.Sc. Nursing course shall be accepted ALONG WITH RELIEVING CERTIFICATE FROM THEIR EMPLOYER.

16. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Medical fitness will be a pre-condition for registration for all candidates. The candidates will be medically examined by a Medical Board, constituted by the PGIMER, Chandigarh for the purpose to determine their medical fitness.

The matter of fee revision is under examination by a committee constituted by the Institute and the recommendation would be applicable on all existing students and likely to joining the students at NINE in accordance with the approval of the competent authority.

18. PENALTY

The following penalty amount will be recovered from students, who will be leaving the studies/course after joining and in between before completion of their course after the last counseling.

1. Penalty Amount : Rs. 50,000/-

Note: Apart from above, the Course fee / security deposit/ any amount under any nomenclature of any kind would not be refunded after leaving the course in between after joining the course and before completion of their studies.

19. SCHEDULE OF DATE FOR PAYMENT OF COURSE FEE

A. NEW/FRESH ADMISSIONS:

Candidates offered admission during counseling must deposit the course fee with the Institute, in the form of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque in favour of "Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh", payable at Chandigarh or any other mode of deposit decided by the Institute. The candidates are advised to bring Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque (to be issued from bank and not from personal cheque book) on the date of counseling and deposit it on the same date and get

the seat confirmed. Those who are not selected may en-cash their Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque from their respective banks later on.

B. OLD STUDENTS

Students already undergoing the course at NINE, on promotion to higher class, will have to pay the course fee within 20 days of start of session i.e. **by 4th August**. In case a student fails to pay the course fee within the stipulated period, the late fee @ Rs.10/- per day will be charged.

20. OTHER INFORMATION

A. DURATION OF COURSE / EXTENSION OF ACADEMIC YEAR.

The duration of M.Sc. Nursing course is of two years. However, in case any student fails to meet the academic / clinical requirements during the two years duration of the course, her / his period of course may be extended to complete the academic / clinical requirements.

Maternity leave: Female students will be entitled to maternity leave as per Govt. of India / PGIMER rules. However, candidates who avail maternity leave during the course their tenure will be extended beyond two years to meet the academic / clinical requirements to be eligible to appear in the exams and for award of degree.

B. LIBRARY

There is a well-equipped spacious library with all the modern facilities at the Institute. Besides this, there is a Nursing Institute Library in the NINE premises with selected professional books and journals.

C. HEALTH FACILITIES FOR STUDENT'S

The services of Nehru Hospital are available to the students at the time of illness in Staff Clinic / OPD as per PGI rules.

21. PREVENTION OF RAGGING

- As per directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside the campus of PGIMER, Chandigarh. The Institute shall initiate STERN ACTION against the offenders. Anyone found involved in ragging will be punished in accordance with law, including expulsion from the Institute and / or imprisonment up to 3 years, along-with fine up to Rs. 25000/-.
- FIR can be lodged against him / her and he / she will be suspended or rusticated from the Institution apart from imposing fine of Rs. 25000/-.
- In case the applicant is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he / she has indulged in ragging, admission can be refused or he / she shall be expelled from the educational institution.

- The punishment may also include suspension from attending the classes, withholding / withdrawing fellowship / scholarship and other financial benefits or withholding the result.

A. ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

An Anti-ragging committee has been constituted by the Institute (Annexure- V) and link to the same has also been given on home page of the official website of the Institute i.e. pgimer.edu.in.

Further, Anti Ragging squads are constituted by the Institute for prevention and prohibition of ragging consisting the faculty of NINE as members of the different teams to make surprise raids on hostels, and other places vulnerable to incidents of ragging and are empowered to inspect such places.

B. ANTI SEXUAL HARASSMENT MONITORING COMMITTEE

A statutory committee, comprising of members from the teaching and non-teaching staff looks into matters related to sexual harassment of students and staff in the college. Any person aggrieved in this matter may fearlessly approach the committee for a fair and concerned hearing and redressal.

The Internal Complaint Committee constituted by the Institute and re-notified from time to time (Annexure – VI of prospectus) can be viewed for respective details of members name, etc. to enable the students to approach them for such cases freely and independently.

22. HOSTEL

No hostel facility is presently available for M.Sc. Nursing candidates. Student coming for studies from out of station / outside Chandigarh needs to make their arrangement of stay at their own.

23. GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING

Democratic atmosphere is maintained among the students and teachers. Students' personal problems are looked into and necessary counseling and guidance is given by the teachers. The students are free to approach any faculty member for the same.

Further, In compliance with Hon'ble supreme Court Judgement dated 24.03.2025 and directions, thereupon, regarding student safety & Mental Health, the Institute has displayed Tele-MANAS Helpline at NINE Hostel to sensitize the students about the availability of mental health support services at the Institute, and to seek professional assistance, whenever required.

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4. SPORTS AND RECREATION

Special emphasis is placed on the recreational facilities for the personal and social development of the students. Extracurricular activities and sports events are organized. Annual Sports Day is organized by the Institute to provide ample opportunities to the students to exhibit their talents.

IMPORTANT NOTE

In case, any candidate found to have supplied false information or certificates etc. or is found to have concealed or withheld any / some information in the application form, his / her admission will be cancelled and he / she will be immediately expelled from the course without any prior notice. 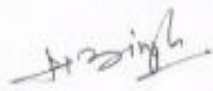
