- Admission to M.Sc. Nursing Course in the state of Punjab will be as per notification issued by Govt. of Punjab from time to time.
- The list of colleges alongwith its status regarding approval of competent authorities will be published on University website. Admission will only be made to the colleges which have permission from all the bodies viz. PNRC, Punjab Government and INC. Candidates are advised to see the Status of college in respect of approval of competent authorities for admission session 2026 viz. affiliation with BFUHS, suitability of Indian Nursing Council, approval of PNRC and Punjab Govt. before getting admission in particular college.
- The candidate will have to submit choices of college /subject/ category through online mode through University website www.bfuhs.ac.in/ www.bfuhs.ggsamch.org and seat will be allocated as per merit cum choice of the applicant provided seat should be available at his/her merit.

5. In 2nd round counseling, all choices filled in first round will be treated as null and void. Only fresh choices will be considered in 2nd round of online counselling. Those candidates who are satisfied with his/her 1st round of allotment and joined the college, need not to submit preferences in subsequent counselling & will retain the first round of seat. Candidates who want to shift/upgrade seat in another college/subject or who have not filled preferences during 1st round of counselling will submit online preferences of colleges/subject/category through University website www.bfuhs.ac.in/ www.bfuhs.ggsmch.org during the 2nd online counselling.
6. The allotment in the counseling will be provisional and subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Nursing College at the time of joining/reporting. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the allocated candidate as per Punjab Government notification/prospectus before joining/admission.
7. Other state candidates not covered under exemption clause will be considered in 2nd/Subsequent counseling after exhausting Punjab State candidates.
8. **The Last date for admission to M.Sc. Nursing course is 30.09.2026 as per Indian Nursing Council notification No.F.No.1-6/(LT)-2026-INC dated 27.01.2026 or any other date as notified by INC/Govt. of Punjab from time to time.**
9. As per the instructions of Govt of Punjab, Director Research Medical Education , Punjab issued vide memo no. 4/13/16-3ME3/7513 dated 25.4.2016, College can not retain the original documents of the admitted candidates.
10. If any candidate is shifted to another College upon upgradation/update of seat, the concerned College will relieve the candidate alongwith original documents to enable him/her to join at the newly allotted college, as per the university rules/regulations.
11. The Principal(s) will constitute the Committee comprising of senior faculty for document verification of the provisionally admitted candidates.
12. The Colleges will allow the online joining of the candidates through college login ID upon completion of checking of original documents/certificates, eligibility as per Punjab Govt Notification and deposition of tuition fee through online university gateway system. The joining of the candidate will not be considered without deposition of tuition fee.

INTRODUCTION

BRIEF HISTORY:

The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. It is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people.

The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9th June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July. 2002. The Regional Director. World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I).

Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers. biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal.

UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

New buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building.

The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacity, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Nursing, University College of Physiotherapy, University Institute of Para-Medical Sciences, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dept. of Nuclear Medicine, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well equipped state-of-the-art 1200 bedded hospital, Drug De-addiction & Treatment Centre at Faridkot. The State Institute of Nursing and Para-Medical Sciences, Village – Badal (Muktsar), Institute of Nursing (University Regional Centre) at Shri Goindwal Sahib and Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre and Drug De-Addiction & Treatment Centre at Bathinda are also run by University.

Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer Centre are in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden.

The university has started number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programs in health sciences and allied services.

Recently, Govt. of Punjab has transferred 100 bedded Civil Hospital, Badal to University for strengthening and expanding the connection between rural medical services and the education and research carried on by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University has 25 departments and 20 post graduate departments.

COLLEGES AFFILIATED WITH UNIVERSITY:

At present the University is having 172 affiliated colleges(09 Medical,14 Dental, 125 Nursing, 09 Physiotherapy, 1 Pharmacy, 1 Sports Medicine and 13 Allied and Health Care Sciences) comprising 160 affiliated and 12 constituent Colleges.

University will soon endeavor to achieve excellence in health care delivery and medical education and research in the State. Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests. The PMNET-2026 is being accordingly conducted to enroll suitable candidates in the Nursing Colleges of the State for the session 2026.

The university is now primarily focusing on strengthening postgraduate medical education and research and evolving as a centre of excellence in a rural backdrop.

Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THIS M. Sc. NURSING, COURSE

5. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
6. **Candidates must retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence.**
 - a. At least three printouts of online submitted application form.
 - b. Proof of fee paid
 - c. 3 copies of latest identical coloured Photograph with date (taken after 01-01-2026 & should be passport size with white background) that scanned and uploaded on the Online Application form.

PLEASE READ IN DETAIL

1. All necessary information regarding the taking of PMNET-2026, allocation of merit and seeking admission to M.Sc. Nursing course in the various Nursing colleges of Punjab affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and all applicable rules and regulations, etc., are contained in this PROSPECTUS, PMNET-2026.
2. This Prospectus contains two parts:
Part-I: Pertains to the instructions/procedure how to fill online application forms for PMNET-2026, Mode of PMNET-2026 and allotment of ranks. It also contains instructions/procedure of online counselling and method of allocation of seats.
Part-II: Pertains to admission to M.Sc. Nursing course on the basis of PMNET-2026. This part contains the **Punjab Government Notification and subsequent notification/amendments to be issued by Govt. of Punjab from time to time**
3. Candidates are advised to read both Part-I and Part-II of the prospectus carefully before filling and submitting the **ONLINE APPLICATION FORM** of PMNET-2026.
4. **An error in filling of ONLINE APPLICATION FORM may result in rejection of such an Application Form. Corrections in the information given by the candidate in the ONLINE APPLICATION FORM may not be permitted after conduct of PMNET.**
5. The schedule of Admission/Counselling shall be notified through the Press or University, website. Changes, if any, in the schedule/time table of Test/Counselling etc. will be notified through website of the University i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in/ www.bfuhs.ggsmch.org **No separate intimation letters will be sent. Candidates are advised to keep in touch with University website regularly.**
6. Candidates must retain this Prospectus with them till admission process is over. Read and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
7. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Part – II of the Prospectus. The Final Eligibility of allocated candidate shall be determined by the Principal of concerned Nursing College before Joining of the candidate.
8. The list of the Colleges and availability of seats shown at various places in this prospectus may vary and **the final status shall be displayed at the time of counselling.**
9. There will be no negative marking. **However, the candidates who do not darken the fifth oval (i.e. option- E introduced for security reasons) in case of un-attempted questions shall be getting deduction of marks at the rate of 1 mark of total marks of each such question.**
10. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just appearing in PMNET-2026 does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Punjab Government Notification and Selection Committee shall be determined eligibility at the time of counselling. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Government Notification will not be considered for admission.
11. Fill category carefully in the online Admission Application Form. Category once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form.

Those candidates, who do not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or fill a wrong category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated in Open merit. The candidate may select a category code from the codes given below and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered applicable

in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counseling in various reserved categories as have been filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats in M.Sc. Nursing courses will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government. No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in online Admission Application Form. In this regard, change in category or any other particulars in online submitted application form will be allowed before the issue of admit card i.e. upto 22.06.2026 and thereafter no change will be allowed under any circumstances

12. **This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution. Ragging is prohibited in all forms.**
13. **HSLIBNET Fee** University has started Health Sciences Library Network (HSLIBNET) to provide access to e-resources to the students of all colleges affiliated with the University for which one time fee Rs. 3000/- or as amended from time to time will be charged from all students who got admission in M.Sc.Nursing Course. HSLIBNET fee will be collected alongwith the tuition fee from students at the time of admission
14. **Hostel Facility:** The hostel facility will not be mandatory to the students whose permanent residence falls within the radius of 10 kilometer from the College
15. **Post Matric Scholarship Scheme:**
 - SC category candidates are entitled for Post Matric scholarship from the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment of Govt. of Punjab if they fulfill their terms and conditions. The candidates will have to submit Freeship Card at the time reporting to the respective colleges and the candidate will generate Freeship Card from the respective website of Punjab Govt. For details regarding this scheme/forms/procedure, respective colleges/candidates should visit the website of Punjab Govt., Deptt. of Medical Education and Research (www.punjabmedicaleducation.org). For any query/clarification, candidates/respective colleges can contact the office of Director, Medical Education and Research, Punjab, Chandigarh or Director, Social Justice & Empowerment Deptt. of Punjab Govt. 16. The candidates, who are getting admission and are in service with any institute, will submit the relieving certificate from the employer at the time of joining in the respective colleges. If later on it is found that he/she is doing service in any institute even after getting the admission, then he/she will be debarred for doing M.Sc. Nursing and action against the student as well as the college will be initiated as per rules of the University. The Principals of respective college will ensure that all the students are regularly attending the classes.

4. After downloading the eligibility application form, candidates will have to submit the same in the University along with a bank draft.
5. The following Original and photocopies of documents are required while submitting eligibility application form is as under:-
 - 1) Copy Admit card/ Result of Entrance Test(PMNET-2026).
 - 2) Copy of the certificate qualifying examination certificate.
 - 3) Date of Birth certificate/Matric Certificate
 - 4) Certificate that qualifying examination has been passed as a regular student from a recognized institution /university.
 - 5) Statement of Marks/ Detail Marks Certificates
 - 6) Character/Conduct certificate from the institution last attended.
 - 7) Copies of the passport of Candidate/Parents in support of NRI proof.
 - 8) Recognition Certificate of B.Sc.(Nursing)/Equivalent Degree from INC.

 - 10) Proof of Punjab Background who will apply under category I

7. **ADMIT CARD:-**

- The syllabus for the course shall be the syllabus of B.Sc.(Nursing)/Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) Course prescribed by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- The test shall be conducted at the centers decided by the University. The city/cities, centre/centres shall be intimated by the University.**
- There shall be no negative marking. **However the candidates who do not darken the fifth oval in case of unattempted questions introduced for security shall be getting deduction of marks at the rate of one mark per question left in which all the five ovals have been left blank.**

15 PROCEDURE OF ONLINE COUNSELLING AFTER DECLARATION OF PMNET-2026 RESULT AND JOINING AT THE ALLOTTED COLLEGE.

The BfuHS will conduct online counseling after declaring the result of PMNET-2026. Counselling for admission to M.Sc. Nursing Course, session 2026 will be conducted online. The schedule of online counsellings including date/time/mode of counselling, will be made available on the website of the University. The candidates will submit online choices / preferences of Colleges, category etc. through university website (www.bfuhs.ac.in/ www.bfuhs.ggsamch.org) as per schedule. The Seats will be allocated as per the PMNET-2026 merit / eligibility criteria as mentioned in the Punjab

Government notification in order of preferences given by the candidate, therefore, candidates are advised to submit preferences / choices carefully.

After provisional allocation of seat, candidates can download provisional allocation letter from the University website after login to their account and will report to the respective allotted college for medical checkup, verification / checking of original documents /eligibility/ deposition of fee as per Punjab Government notification and joining thereafter.

FEE: The provisionally selected candidates will pay the 1st year fee through online payment gateway on university website.

Merely, issuing of Provisional allotment letter does not confer any right to claim the allocated seat as their provisional allotment is subject to verification of documents and checking of eligibility as per terms and conditions of Punjab Govt. Notification/Prospectus.

If any candidate will not report for joining to the respective college upto stipulated period or will not pay the requisite counselling/tuition fee etc. or found ineligible as per Punjab Government notification at any stage, his/her allocated seat will be cancelled automatically without any intimation and his/her seat shall be declared as vacant for the subsequent round of counseling.

In case, candidate wishes/intends to upgrade/change his/her seat/category then he/she will have to participate in the subsequent round of counselling by submitting preferences/choices afresh for the course/college/category/Quota. If candidate is satisfied with seat allocated to him/her during online counselling, he/she is not required to participate in the subsequent rounds of counselling.

1. GENERAL:

- 1.1 The Governor of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot to conduct Entrance Test for 2020 and onwards and corresponding years hereinafter, for selection of candidates for admission to M.Sc. Nursing courses in various institutions, in the State of Punjab, for the year 2020 and onwards.
- 1.2 All institutions affiliated with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot/Indian Nursing Council (INC)/Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC) whether Government/Private /aided/unaided shall be covered by this notification.
- 1.3 The admission to the minority institutions in the State of Punjab shall be done as per the notification/instructions /guidelines/rules/executive orders passed from time to time by the Government of Punjab as per provisions of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended upto date.
- 1.4 The Governor of Punjab is further pleased to notify that no institution shall select candidates out of any other source or in any other manner other than merit of the candidates in entrance examination conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot on the basis of syllabus of B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. (post basic nursing). There shall be no overlapping or bye-passing of entrance examination merit of candidates.
- 1.5 After the declaration of the result of the entrance examination the candidates will have to apply on the specific proforma for all seats except minority quota seats to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (BFUHS), Faridkot. Admission will be made by the admission committee under the chairmanship of BFUHS, Faridkot through a centralized counselling purely on merit in an open, transparent manner on the basis of inter-se merit of entrance examination at the earliest possible and it shall be ensured that the final counseling by the University (BFUHS) shall be completed by 31st October of this year and thereafter, individual Institutions

would be at liberty to fill-up vacant seats in the presence of representatives of BFUHS.

- 1.6 For the admission in minority quota, the candidate shall have to apply to concerned institute. Seats shall be filled purely on merit, through institute level admission committee in an open, transparent manner on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in entrance examination.
- 1.7 The reserve category candidate shall have the right to compete for admission in general category seats as per their merit on the day of counselling and candidates so selected will not be counted towards admission in the reserve category.
- 1.8 The details of the institutions and category wise seats will be available on the official website of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in
- 1.9 The entrance examination shall be conducted by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot by setting up of adequate number of centers, at such places as the University may deem fit.
- 1.10 After Centralized Counseling for admission to M.Sc. Nursing course conducted by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot if seats are still vacant after exhausting the merit list of Entrance Test, then the left over seats may be filled by concerned college in the presence of nominated member of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot on the basis of inter-se-merit of B.Sc. NOTE: THE DETAILS OF PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS AND THEIR SEAT DISTRIBUTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PUNJAB GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS ISSUED AS PER PROVISIONS OF THE PUNJAB PRIVATE HEALTH SCIENCES EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION, FIXATION OF FEE AND MAKING OF RESERVATION) ACT 2006 AND NOTIFICATIONS ISSUED FROM TIME TO TIME BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

2.3 Distribution of seats shall be as per provisions of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended upto date.

2.4 The admission shall be made to all the institutions, which have got the permission from the concerned authority and are affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot by 31st October of the corresponding year.

2.5 The seats remaining vacant in government quota shall be transferred to management quota and vice versa.

- 2.6 The seats remaining vacant after exhausting the state list, will be filled from candidates who have passed qualifying examination from the recognized institutions situated outside the State of Punjab irrespective of place of residence, in an open, transparent manner on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination by the same committee.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Following candidates are eligible:-

- (a) Candidate should have obtained certificate in B.Sc. (Nursing)/ B.Sc. (Post Basic Nursing) from an institution recognized by the Punjab Nursing Registration Council/Indian Nursing Council and situated in the state of Punjab. (The Clause of Institute situated in state of Punjab is exempted for those exempted under clause 3 (b) and NRI Quota, or
- (b) The candidate was bonafide resident of Punjab. The resident status of Punjab state shall be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95 3PP-II/9619 dated 6th June, 1996 and any further instructions issued by the Department of Personnel, if any, and the same shall be adhered to, or
- (c) In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission in M.Sc. Nursing course in Nursing institutes in Punjab:-
 - i) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
 - ii) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI category.
 - iii) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
 - iv) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However, those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.
 - v) Candidates under J & K migrant for J & K migrant quota seats only.

Note-1 The candidates should have passed B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Post Basic Nursing with minimum 55% marks from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot or equivalent examination with requisite percentage of marks as prescribed above in this para, recognized by Indian Nursing Council, from a recognized University. In case candidate passed qualifying examination from IGNOU, New Delhi, study center must be recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi.

Note-2 Candidates should have at least one year of work experience at the time of joining of the course in Bed Side Nursing or Public Health Nursing or Nursing Educational Institute recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC) after Basic. B.Sc. Nursing or before/after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.

Note-3 In the first instance admission to the institutions having permission of affiliation from all the Statutory bodies, i.e., Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC)/Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) and Indian Nursing Council (INC), shall be finalized purely on merit and in transparent manner. The institutions which secure these permissions up to 30th September of the corresponding year, shall also be considered.

Note-4 The dependency certificate in case of those candidates whose parents are not alive, shall have also to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner of the District where the candidate resides.

4. RESERVATION:

A. For Government/University College:

The reservation in the State quota seats in Government Institutions in various categories for admission to the under Graduate Para Medical Courses will be as under:

(i)	Schedule Caste	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes	10%
(iii)	Differently abled	5%

Note 1. The availability of seats for reservation shall be as per 100 point roster being maintained category wise / subject wise / institution wise.

Note 2. All the certificates shall be as per the latest instructions issued by the Govt. of Punjab.

B. For Private Institutes:

The reservation in private institutes (in Government/Management quota seats) will be as under:-

i.	Scheduled Caste -	25%
ii.	Backward Classes-	10%
iii.	Differently abled	5%

Note : Distribution of seats under Management/ Minority quota for the admission to Minority institutes shall be as fixed by the respective institutions in accordance with applicable laws.

C. Explanation: The following points shall be observed while granting above reservation both in government and in private colleges:

- (i) The reservation of physically challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act – 2016.
- (ii) The above reservation will be made in each Course/ college separately subject to the availability of seats as per instructions issued by the Government of Punjab from time to time. The reservation in each institution shall not exceed 25 % in case of SC and 35% in case of SC and BC combined together.
- (iii) General category counselling shall be held on the first day. The reserved category candidate selected shall have the right to be selected in the General category as per her/his merit. The reserve category candidate selected in the general category shall not be counted towards reserve category.
- (iv) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve category shall be merged with the general category seats.

5. Non-Resident Indian (NRI) SEATS

15% seats in all Private Institutes and 7.5% of seats in Government / University institutes shall be earmarked for the Foreign Indian Students (NRI). The Foreign Indian Students (NRI) quota in Private Institute will be part of the Management Quota.

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

- (i) Under this policy non resident Indian means a person of Indian origin whether holding an Indian Passport or foreign passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case :

- (i) for or on taking up employment outside India ; or
- (ii) for carrying on a business or vacation outside India ; or
- (iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intension to stay outside India for an uncertain period.

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant document including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency

of Foreign Country issued by competent authority or OCI / PIO Card issued by the Govt. of India shall be taken into consideration.

- (ii) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.
- (iii) The fee notified for NRI category shall be applicable to NRI candidates getting admission to Govt. Nursing Colleges also.
- (iv) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.
- (v) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, during / after 2nd Centralized Counselling of NRI quota in State Colleges, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges/Minority colleges shall go to General Category of the Management/ Minority quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee from amongst the eligible candidates of Entrance Test.

6. ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- 6.1 The selection shall be strictly as per merit based upon the entrance examination.
- 6.2 Candidate should have secured at least 40% (35% for SC/BC) in the Entrance Test.
- 6.3 Counseling shall be compulsory and the centralized counseling shall be conducted by the committee consisting of the members as per clause 7(A) of this notification.
- 6.4 **EQUAL MARKS:** - In case of candidates securing equal marks their inter-se-merit will be determined as under:-
 - i) Firstly the candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks calculated up to 3 decimal points.
 - ii) Candidate having higher percentage of aggregate marks calculated up to 3 decimal points in final year B.SC (NURSING)/ B.SC (POST BASIC NURSING).
 - iii) Then the candidate, older in age.

Note 1: The fee for Govt. /private Institutes shall be as fixed by the Government of Punjab as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 as amended from time to time.

Note 2: The fee structure subject to change as per requirements of the year of admission. Each and every student has to furnish and undertaking to the effect to deposit the enhance fee as per revised rates fixed by the Government from time to time keeping in view the year of admission.

- v. These charges are exclusive of electricity/ water but inclusive of everything else.

Note 1 Successful candidates shall deposit the fee in form of Demand Draft in favour of Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences payable at Faridkot which will be deposited at the time of counseling.

Note 2 The above charges (include Tuition fee / Amalgamated Fund etc.) as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time. The clinical fee will be charged on monthly basis @ 700/- P.M. from the student. The transport and all other charges shall be optional and will be charged on actual user basis.

Note 3 The fee will be payable on six monthly basis and the colleges will not insist to deposit of fee of the entire course in advance. At the most students can be asked to submit a bank Guarantee / Bond that they will be liable to pay the balance fee for the whole courses even if they left in midstream.

Note 4 The fee shall be refunded / adjusted if candidate is shifted from one course / college to another in subsequent round of counseling / operation of waiting list. If the said fee is not refunded / adjusted within 15 days then said institute will be liable to pay Bank Interest as well as penal interest to the said student as laid by R.B.I.

9. (i) **Declaration by students-** Candidates and their parents will have to give a declaration if they (candidates) have already got admission in a course in any other State that they will leave that seat if they opt for admission through PUNJAB M.SC ENTERANCE EXAMINATION-2020 and corresponding years and will send a copy of the declaration to the concerned institute where they have already deposited fee/occupied a seat. They shall also give a declaration that they have not got admission in any other state on any other basis of any other qualifying examination except the one on the basis of which they have appeared in PUNJAB M.SC ENTERANCE EXAMINATION.
- (ii) **Students already admitted in previous years-**Any candidate who has taken admission in the previous sessions in M.Sc. Nursing courses shall be eligible for fresh admission in new M.Sc. Nursing Courses as a fresh candidate based on basis of result of Punjab M.Sc. Nursing Entrance examination. However, in case a candidate was admitted previously and drops out or leaves the M.Sc. Nursing Courses in between and seeks a fresh admission, the candidate shall have to deposit fee for full course.

10. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (a) The students shall pay the fees and other charges, for all types of seats, as per the rates of fees and other charges fixed by the Government of Punjab from time to time.
- (b) Managements/Minority Quota including Foreign Indian Students (NRI) seats will be filled up as per the notification/ instructions/ guidelines/ Executive orders by the State Government as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006 or any directions or the orders of the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court/ Supreme Court of India.
- (c) The seats available for admission will be displayed on the notice board of the University and a List of corresponding year result shall be supplied by the University to all the Institutions on payment basis (at the price to be fixed by the University). The University will submit three sets of gazette to the Government free of cost.
- (d) If a candidate who has deposited his / her fee for six months opt to surrender his/her selection / seat, ten days before the last date fixed for the admission in the given course, the institute shall not be entitled to enforce bank guarantee / surety bond against that student for the recovery of the balance fee. However, the fee deposited for six months shall not be refunded.
- (e) The admissions shall be made to only those institutes, which are affiliated to the University on or before 31st October, 2020 and have obtained the permissions of affiliations from all the Statutory Bodies, i.e. Punjab Nurses Registration Council (PNRC)/ Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) and Indian Nurses Council (INC) and shall be finalized purely on merit and in a transparent manner.
- (f) The Medical Board to determine requisite disability at the time of admission will be constituted by the Chairman Selection Committee/ University. The candidate shall be admitted only if she/he has minimum of the requisite disability and with this disability is otherwise found fit medically to pursue the concerned course, by a duly constituted Medical Board.
- (g) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed course (s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination (s) in time, no admission(s), adjustments(s) shall be made after 30th November of the corresponding years, regardless of any vacancy(ies) that might exist or might arise thereafter for any reason whatsoever.
- (h) Government quota seats remaining vacant will be transferred to management quota and Vice versa filled up by the University as per provisions of this notification; strictly as per their merit, after obtaining a certificate from the Selection Committees that there are no candidates available with them and they are unable to fill up the government quota. If seats remain vacant after

exhausting all qualifying candidates the institutes may approach the government for relaxation in eligibility for admission through BFUHS.

- (i) No admissions shall be made after 30th November, 2020 of the corresponding years, including the left over seats without prior permission from the Punjab Government (Request should be routed through BFUHS, Faridkot).
- (j) Any notification/instructions issued earlier shall not be applicable to admission for the session 2020 and corresponding year.
- (k) For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this notification, the jurisdiction shall be under section 8 of the Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of fee and Making of Reservation) Act, 2006.

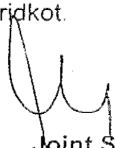

The Governor of Punjab is pleased to notify as per provisions contained in "The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of admission, fixation of fee and making of reservation Act, 2006 (Punjab Act No. 6 of 2006) fee structure for Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (A.N.M) course, Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Basic) course and Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Post Basic) course in Government/Private Medical Colleges as under:-

1. That the fee for government institutions is to be fixed lower than private institutions.
2. GNM course fee should not be revised as the course is expected to be stopped by the Indian Nursing Council from 2021.
3. ANM course fee is to be increased from Rs.5000 per year to Rs.7000 per year in Government institutions, and from Rs.14375 per year to Rs.18000 per year in private institutions.
4. Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Basic) and Bachelor of Science, Nursing (Post Basic) course fee is Rs.40000 per year in Government institutions and no increase is proposed for these; however, in private institutions it is to be increased from Rs.40250 per year to Rs.50000 per year.
5. The fee of Master of Science (Nursing) course in Government institutions is Rs.100000 per year and in private institutions it is Rs.175000 and no increase is to be made in this fee.
6. The increase in fee will be applicable prospectively, i.e. to new students only, joining the new session from 2020-21 onwards. All existing enrolled students will continue to pay at old rates for the full course.
7. It was also decided that fee should be increased annually in Government and Private both institutions by 5% for 5 years for subsequent batches, and fee be reviewed again after 5 years, with rounding off to nearest hundred.
8. The instructions issued in this regard as per Finance Department with their vide letter no. FD-FE-204/3/2020-4FE2/1/67354/2020, dated 24.08.2020 and letter no. FD-FE-201/19/2020-4FE2/1/54970/2020, dated 27.07.2020 will be applicable, which state that Department of Medical Education and Research has been allowed to retain till 31.12.2020 the amount collected as User Charges by institutions coming under its



purview. Thereafter, government medical colleges will deposit fee (along with un-spent amount with interest) in the treasury as per guidelines of Finance Department dated 01.04.2020

I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

**Affidavit/Certificate and the authorities
competent to issue the same**

- (a) Citizen of India
- (b) Produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their Children/wards have not obtained the benefit of Residence in any other State

attested by an Executive Magistrate/Oath

Categories

- i) Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding the qualifying examination for the admission. Certificate to be issued by the Headmaster/Principal of the Govt. and recognized Schools/Colleges concerned.
- ii) Children wards of
- a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of service. Certificate to be issued by respective Head of the Department
- b) The employee of Govt. of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. - do -
- c) The employees of State Govt. institutions/undertakings who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. - do -
- d) The employees having atleast 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Govt. has 20% or more shares: - do -
- e) The Residents who are residing outside Punjab on Account of their service either with the GOI or with the employees of the Govt. of Punjab in the matter of issue of 'Residence Certificate' provided the permanent address of such employees fall in the reorganized Punjab i.e. on or after 01.11.66, as per their service books. - do -
- f) *The employees borne on the establishment of Punjab and the Haryana High Court discharging duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Punjab having atleast three years of service who have not availed this facility from their parent State and State of Haryana and U.T; Chandigarh -do-
- iii) **Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab.** PPO issued by the Accountant General, Punjab.
- iv) Children/wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or had resided in Punjab for a period of atleast 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job. Certificate to be issued by the DC, ADC (R), ADC (D), SDM, GA to DC, DORG, DRO, EM, Tehsildar, Commissioners of Municipal Corporations of Amritsar, Jalandhar and Ludhiana.
- v) Children/wards of persons who have held immovable property in Punjab for a period of 5 years, the property should be in the name of the parents/guardians or the candidate himself. DC, ADC(R), ADC(D), SDM, GA to DC, EM, DORG, Tehsildar/DRO based on copies of Jamabandi, Revenue Record, Municipal Record, Registered deeds or any other documents to the full satisfaction of the DC.

From: Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab to all the Heads of the department etc.
Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PMET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:-

- i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
- ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
- iii)(a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application form whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitling him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
- iii)(b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
- iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
- v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record.
